

2010 Topeka Mixed Team and Doubles Tournament Rules and Regulations

- 1.** Only members of the Topeka USBC BA or Topeka USBC WBA are eligible to enter this tournament.
- 2.** Entrants shall use their highest average based on a minimum of 21 games from the previous 2008 - 2009 yearbook in Topeka. The 10 pin rule is in effect for this tournament. If a bowler's current January 1, 2010 average is 10 or more pins higher than last season's highest book average, they must use the current average. A bowler with no book average from the prior season may use a current season's January 1 average with a minimum of 21 games. Otherwise, they must enter with a scratch average of 220. Female members that have dual memberships must enter with their overall highest average. Please note that it is the individual bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average submitted regardless of who submitted this entry form. Failure to use the correct average could result in disqualification and loss of any or all prize money won.
- 3.** There shall be three events in this tournament, a four member (2 male, 2 female) team, mixed doubles and individual all events based on gender. Participation will be limited to two team events and one doubles team. The All Events category is optional. No more than two players may compete on a team more than once. A bowler's first team event score will count for All Events.
- 4.** Entry per person per event shall be \$18.00. The optional All Events shall be \$5.00 per person. Please only one method of payment per entry.
- 5.** If a substitute bowls in the two 3 game events for the same person and the original all events fee was paid, the sub is eligible for any all events prizes.
- 6.** This shall be a handicap tournament. Handicap will be 90% from a scratch basis of 220 and will be figured on an individual basis.
- 7.** Closing date for entries shall be February 28 at midnight.
- 8.** Prize ratio for all of the events shall be at least one place for each six entries. All prize money will be returned 100%. An estimated prize list will be posted at the tournament's check-in table.
- 9.** Team captains will be notified in writing of dates and times of their scheduled time to bowl. It is the bowler's responsibility to verify their scheduled time to bowl as the tournament manager will not be held responsible for any individual.
- 10.** Tournament management reserves the right to make any and all decisions in any emergency that may arise.
- 11.** Tournament entrants shall bowl in the exact order names appear on the entry form.
- 12.** Any entrant who arrives after a game has started will be allowed to bowl, but scoring shall begin in the frame then being bowled. No score will be given for any missed frames.
- 13.** Pacers will not be allowed.
