

**Topeka USBC Bowling Association**  
**Senior and Super Senior Bowler of the Year - Point System**

1. To be considered for the Senior and Super Senior Bowler of the Year award, members must meet or exceed the following requirements.
  - A. Must be a member in good standing of the Topeka USBC Bowling Association.
  - B. Bowl in a minimum of one league at a bowling center in the City of Topeka.
  - C. Bowl a minimum of 2/3 of the league's scheduled games (i.e., 68 of 102).
  - D. Senior Bowler: 55 – 67 years old; Super Senior 68+ years old  
 (Bowler of the Year category will be determined by age as of August 1).
2. Average: Highest average in certified Topeka USBC BA leagues, day or evening, (excluding travel leagues), will be used. NOTE: Final average sheets not received by the Topeka USBC Bowling Association Manager by May 5 may not be accepted. Points for the ten highest averages will be assigned as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup> = 50 points	2 <sup>nd</sup> = 45 points	3 <sup>rd</sup> = 40 points	4 <sup>th</sup> = 35 points
5 <sup>th</sup> = 30 points	6 <sup>th</sup> = 25 points	7 <sup>th</sup> = 20 points	8 <sup>th</sup> = 15 points
9 <sup>th</sup> = 10 points	10 <sup>th</sup> = 5 points		

3. Honor Scores: Nationally recognized honor score will be awarded points assigned as follows:

Series	Games
850 – 900 = 50 points	300 = 10 points
800 – 849 = 40 points	299 = 8 points
775 – 799 = 30 points	298 = 6 points
750 – 774 = 20 points	
725 – 749 = 10 points	
700 – 724 = 5 points	
11 in a row = 4 points
